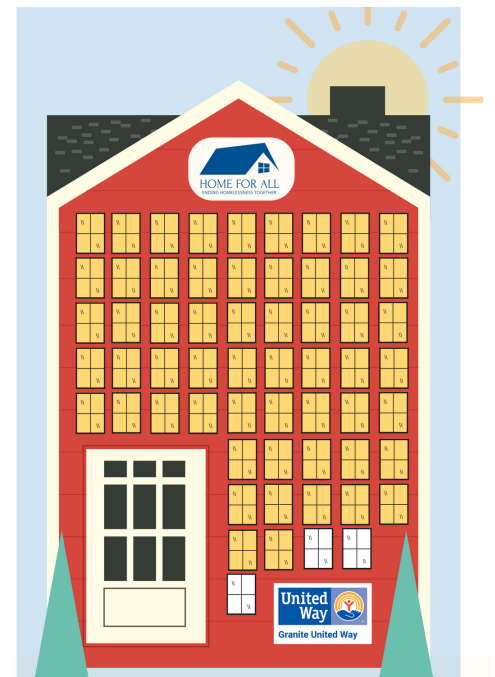

AHIP BY THE NUMBERS

Thank you AHIP Shelter and Referral partners! Together we moved over **102 individuals** out of homelessness and into permanent housing between **January and September 2022**. This opened up more than **60 shelter beds** on the Seacoast, moved 5 individuals/families out of places not meant for habitation, and **diverted 39 individuals/families out of unstable housing situations** that put them at risk of becoming homeless or unsheltered.

PARTNER NEWS & UPDATES

Last week it was announced that SOS will take over the operations of the Willand Drive Emergency Warming Center. Please see the relevant updates from John Burns, ED of SOS below.

SOS expects the center to be activated for approximately 80-90 nights between November 25th and March 31st 2023. The center will be staffed from 5pm-9am when activated.

Collaboration Needed: John is looking to see if any HFA agencies would be will to help provide support in the way of offering intakes for connections to permanent housing for those at the Willand Drive Emergency Warming Center. While hours of operations may pose challenges for some agencies, it would be helpful to have partner agencies come between 7 and 8am before gearing up transports to offsite locations or alternatively in the evenings between 7 and 8 pm after dinner is wrapping up. John hopes to have a small cubicle dedicated to all our valuable partners who can make a difference in the lives of those we serve by helping connect clients to supportive services.

On **Monday November 14, 2022** there will be an **agency collaboration meeting on zoom** to brainstorm high level ideas. ***This meeting is ONLY for agencies that can support the effort.***
